IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Night detours of Gateway Motorway (Deagon to Bracken Ridge) – November/December 2018

The Gateway Motorway between Nudgee and Bracken Ridge is now constructed to its final width, with the project team progressing finishing works ahead of project completion. The project team thanks motorists and the community for their ongoing understanding and patience during these works.

Works include:

As part of these finishing works, asphaltting will be carried out on the Gateway Motorway at night between mid-November and mid-December 2018. To facilitate asphaltting on both the northbound and southbound carriageways, **night time detours of the Gateway Motorway will be required between Deagon and Bracken Ridge, including:**

Northbound motorway detour:

Motorists travelling northbound towards the Bruce Highway will be diverted via the Deagon Deviation overpass (Exit 120A), the Deagon Deviation northbound lanes, the Deagon Deviation northbound off-ramp to Bracken Ridge Road (Exit 122), Bracken Ridge Road and the Bracken Ridge Road northbound on-ramp – refer to the map overleaf for details.

Southbound motorway detour:

Motorists travelling southbound towards Brisbane City will be diverted via the Bracken Ridge Road southbound off-ramp (Exit 123), Bracken Ridge Road, Deagon Deviation southbound on-ramp, Deagon Deviation and the Deagon Deviation southbound on-ramp to the Gateway Motorway.

At the completion of each asphaltting night shift, line marking will be reinstated, either with temporary markers or permanent on-road paint, and **the motorway will be reopened to traffic each morning.**

What to expect:

- Changed traffic conditions, including a **signed detour of the Gateway Motorway northbound and southbound between Deagon and Bracken Ridge**, as well as reduced speed limits and increased presence of traffic controllers and police.
- Short-term traffic delays may be experienced during night-time working hours. Motorists are encouraged to plan their journey accordingly.

- Removal of temporary traffic barriers and existing line marking, with the road and traffic lanes to be delineated using temporary markers until final asphaltting and permanent line marking is complete.
- Increased noise, vibration, odour and lighting levels during night works.
- Use of large machinery, including asphalt pavers, profilers, rollers, bobcats and other equipment.
- Increased construction traffic accessing work areas and site compounds fitted with flashing lights and reversing beepers for safety reasons.

Working hours:

These asphaltting works will be undertaken on night shifts between the hours of **7pm and 5am, Sundays to Fridays** from mid-November until mid-December 2018. All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.

Other ongoing finishing works

Other ongoing finishing works will be carried out in your local area during November and December 2018, including:

Guardrail installation:

Sections of guardrail will be progressively installed at night along the Gateway Motorway and Deagon Deviation lanes. **Please note: increased noise and vibration levels are associated with guardrail works.**

Electrical infrastructure installation:

Electrical infrastructure will continue to be installed progressively alongside the motorway to service new overhead signage and motorway lighting. Works will involve excavation and the use of heavy construction equipment, which may generate increased noise.

Working hours:

These construction activities must be carried out at night when traffic volumes are lower and lane closures can be implemented safely. The night-time working hours for these activities are:

- **Sundays** - 7.00pm to 5.30am
- **Mondays to Thursdays** – 6.30pm to 5.30am
- **Fridays** – 6.30pm to 7.00am.





Black line: Night time detours of the Gateway Motorway, Sundays to Fridays from mid-November until mid-December 2018, including:

- northbound carriageway: 9pm to 5am
- southbound carriageway: 7pm to 3am.

Yellow line: Signed diversion route for northbound Gateway Motorway carriageway via Deagon Deviation overpass (Exit 120A), the Deagon Deviation northbound lanes, the Deagon Deviation northbound off-ramp to Bracken Ridge Road (Exit 122), Bracken Ridge Road and the Bracken Ridge Road northbound on-ramp.

Blue line: Signed diversion route for southbound Gateway Motorway carriageway via Bracken Ridge Road southbound off-ramp (Exit 123), Bracken Ridge Road, Deagon Deviation southbound on-ramp, Deagon Deviation and the Deagon Deviation southbound on-ramp to the Gateway Motorway.

Stay up-to-date during the works

Local residents and road users are encouraged to stay up-to-date with changed traffic conditions during the project's asphaltting night works by regularly checking **QLDTraffic** for updates.

QLDTraffic is the trusted, official source of traffic and travel information from the Queensland Government. It includes the website www.qldtraffic.qld.gov.au, the **13 19 40** phone service, social media and the **QLDTraffic** smartphone app, enabling motorists and commuters to check traffic conditions and plan their journeys before they go.
